



2023 PINOT NOIR | CALIFORNIA

NOSE: Indicative of this wine's taste. Notes of baking chocolate, berry basket and dark cherries.

PALATE: Defined by its texture and the flavor of dark cherries. Soft throughout, with the feel of fine cocoa powder.

INSPIRATION: Winemaker Charlie Wagner's passion for the California coast. At every opportunity, he travels to places like Monterey or Big Sur – “windbreaker country” whose rugged beauty and ocean influence translate to complexity in the glass.

SOURCING: Coastal regions of California. Ocean breezes temper the sun, allowing grapes to stay on the vine longer for enhanced flavor.

DIFFERENTIATOR: Silky with rich fruit. A layered wine with a bright character - highly enjoyable and versatile. Enjoy slightly chilled.

SUGGESTED FOOD PAIRINGS: Cacio e pepe, carnitas tacos, spicy grilled shrimp or wild mushroom risotto.
